04) Special Note

Children born outside Sri Lanka whose birth is registered with a Sri Lankan Mission abroad are issued with certificates under the consular functions act by the registrar generals' office and under the Ceylon citizenship act by the department of **Immigration** and Emigration http://www.immigration.gov.lk/web/index.php?option=com_content&view=article&id=149&Itemid= 188&lang=en. Certificates issued by the department of Immigration and Emigration will become void on reaching the age 21 years at which the child will have to decide whether to retain Sri Lanka citizenship or the citizenship of the birth or both by making an application to the department of Immigration and Emigration before he/she completes the age 21 years.

If the applicant does not comply with this requirement, he/she will automatically lose Sri Lankan citizenship as stated in the bottom of the certificate issued by the department of Immigration and Emigration. In view of the above it is advisable for the presents to keep their children informed of this requirement.
